

INSTRUCTIONS FOR INTRODUCER

1. Introducer should have a gregarious personality as the introduction is of a light, humorous nature and should be read accordingly, with the proper pauses as noted and emphasis on the underlined phrases as indicated.
2. Introducer may precede formal written introduction with off-the-cuff comments of an informal nature about Mikki in regard to having heard or met her or heard something about her previously. It is not to be stated that she has given the introduction to be read, as that would take away from one of the opening lines.
3. A suggestion "I would now like to read a more formal introduction of Mikki." Please read verbatim, do not ad lib, as much of Mikki's opening remarks are related back to the introduction and the success of the humor is based upon adherence to the structure as is.
4. Any additional comments that the introducer would like to change or add should be approved of with Mikki, prior to the presentation.
